Saturday, November 11, 2006 was a good day for the T.D.A. Board of Trustees to meet in Nashville in our impressive new building. A gray rainy day kept the hours spent indoors (9:30 a.m. to 4:30 p.m.) enjoyable. High points will follow in random order.

Our new Treasurer, Dr. Jay Hight from Jackson, reports we are operating in the black with no surprise. He also states non-dues revenue is what is saving us and advises our long overdue dues increase is very much needed to get us into a more stable cash flow situation.

Dr. Fred Heros from Memphis, President Elect, asks all of us to be aware of not only new members but former members of our association. Please do not hesitate to voice membership values to both new prospects and voided members. The dentist next door or down the street who used to be a member but has dropped out needs you. Keep in touch with each other.

Dr. Underwood, our President, assures us we want to keep communication lines between dentists and assistants open.
