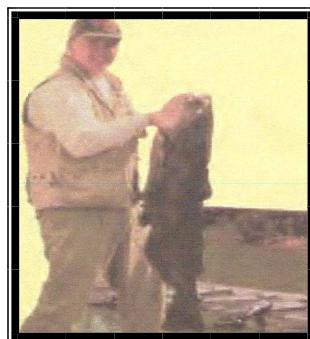

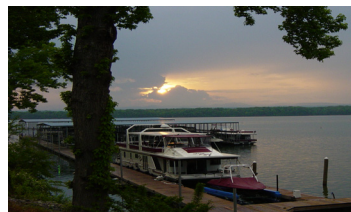

Rules for Fishing Rodeo:

1. You must pay your \$50.00 entry fee to be eligible for the largest bass and the most bass category prizes. By entering this will make you eligible for one of two \$1000.00 prizes.
2. The **bass fishing categories** will follow professional tournament rules.
 - Artificial lures only
 - Fish must be weighed in alive or a one pound penalty will be assessed for each dead fish.
 - There is a five fish limit for the largest stringer
 - Largemouth size limit is 15" and smallmouth limit is 18" on Watts Bar Lake
3. All Tennessee laws and fishing regulations apply
4. A \$1000.00 first prize will be awarded for the largest legal limit of black bass (largemouth, smallmouth, and spotted bass.)
5. A \$1000.00 lunker prize will be given for the largest bass.
6. In all other categories, any legal fishing method is permitted. Minnows, worms, catfish bait, etc. Lots of good prizes will be given for other categories.
7. Size and creel limits for other species:

Crappie	10"	creel limit	30
Sauger	15"	creel limit	10
White bass	15"	creel limit	15
Striped bass	15"	creel limit	2
Catfish	—no limit but only one fish over 34"		
Bluegill	—no limit
