

**TRUSTEE'S REPORT:**

On Saturday, August 15th, the Board of Trustees met in Nashville at the TDA headquarters. Our first order of business was a discussion on access to care issues. There were three presentations made:

Dr. Elenora Wood with the Dental Angel Foundation which is based in Chattanooga. She explained how her organization worked by providing funds for uninsured individuals to have extractions done in participating offices. Next, Dr. Tom Underwood shared information with us about the progress being made with the state legislature to provide adult emergency service to those in need. Then we discussed Knoxville based Remote Area Medical's work in Tennessee and surrounding areas as well as the weeklong RAM expedition that was in progress in Los Angeles. We also got a chance to see the ADA comparison of some of the federal healthcare proposals.

After a review of the TDA's strategic plan and the Board Policy Manual, we got a report on the annual session held in Knoxville in May. Thankfully, attendance was better than anticipated and the meeting not only provided great CE courses and social events, but also was a financial success.

I am glad to report that at this time, TDA membership is stable and the organization is financially sound in spite of the current financial climate. Please take advantage of the TDA journals excellent CE credits. The income from these courses will help keep the cost of membership low.

I encourage you to make a large contribution to Tenn-D-Pac. The leadership in Washington has made healthcare reform a priority, and every year we are faced with legislation in Nashville that would have a negative effect on Tennessee dentists. A strong PAC allows us to have a voice with our legislators.
