Dr. Bill Bass, a world-renowned forensic anthropologist, founded the University of Tennessee's Anthropology Research Facility -- the Body Farm -- a quarter-century ago. He is the author or coauthor of more than two hundred scientific publications, as well as a critically acclaimed memoir about his career, *Death's Acre*. Dr. Bass is also a dedicated teacher, honored as National Professor of the Year by the Council for Advancement and Support of Education. Jefferson is a veteran journalist, writer, and documentary filmmaker. His writings have been published in the *New York Times*, *Newsweek*, *USA Today*, and *Popular Science* and broadcast on National Public Radio. The coauthor of *Death's Acre*, he is also the writer and producer of two highly rated National Geographic documentaries about the Body Farm.

Dr. Bass attended the University of Virginia for his undergraduate degree, and received his master's from the University of Kentucky. He completed his Ph.D. in Anthropology from the University of Pennsylvania in 1961. His research career began as an archaeologist, excavating Native American grave sites in the Midwest United States during the 1950s. He mentions in *Death's Acre*, somewhat humorously, that this activity earned him the informal title "Indian grave-robber number one" from the local Native American leaders.

At the October 30, 2009 Earl Henry Memorial Clinic, Dr. Bill Bass will be discussing how "your teeth are your ID." At the close of this meeting attendees will have the opportunity to reserve a copy of the newest Dr. Bass book, *The Bone Thief*, which is set to be released February 2010. Attendees will also have a chance to purchase a hard cover copy of his other six books, as well as have them autographed by Dr. Bass. Bone Zones—the company that handles selling these intriguing books, can only take **checks or cash**.
