Dear Members of the Second District Dental Society,

We have extended our fundraiser for one more month. The Alliance of the Second District Dental Society ask for your help in educating the Second District community in proper dental hygiene. We cannot do this without your help.

For the year of 2017 – 2018 we distributed over 6,000 toothbrushes and toothpaste tubes, 600 ADA activity books and posters and \$3500 in grants and scholarships within our eighteen East Tennessee counties. A \$500 donation was made to Remote Area Medical to assist with their free dental health clinics. In recognition of National Children's Dental Health Month, the first babies born in February in area hospitals received gifts baskets emphasizing dental health for parents and children. We continue to participate in health and career fairs at schools and businesses {smokeless tobacco, ENDS, the HPV16 vaccine and tobacco cessation}. The DOE employee health fair, Roane State Community College second year dental hygiene class, the University of Tennessee's College of Nursing health fair for faculty and students, Inskip Elementary School, Knox Area Urban League's back to school health fair for surrounding counties and a food pantry at a local church are just a few recipients of dental health materials from Second District Dental Alliance.

These projects would not be possible without the funds generated from our **HOLIDAY DENTAL HEALTH FUNDRAISER**. Your \$40.00 contribution will be acknowledged **in the February Second District Dental Society Newsletter**. Your donation must be submitted no later than January 11, 2019.

SDDS CONSTITUTION & BYLAWS PROPOSED AMMENDMENT

Please notice amendments are typed in italics

CHAPTER II – “Executive Committee” or “Board of Directors” for the Second District Dental Society

Section 10. COMPOSITION: The Board of Directors/Executive Committee of this Society shall consist of the President, the Immediate Past-President, the President-Elect, the Secretary, the Treasurer, Vice President, and the Chairman of the New Dentist Committee. The Executive Director and the Trustee to the TDA from the SDDS shall be ex-officio members of the Board without the right to vote.

Section 20. QUORUM: Forty (40) percent of the board members shall constitute a quorum for the transaction of business.

Section 30. DUTIES: The Board of Directors/Executive Committee shall transact the business of this Society and make regular reports to the membership. It shall, in case of a vacancy in the office of President elect, Secretary, or Treasurer, be empowered to appoint a member to the office who shall serve until the next annual meeting.

Section 40. EXECUTIVE DIRECTOR: The Executive Committee/Board of Directors shall have the responsibility of employing and/or terminating the employment of an executive director by a vote of a simple majority of the Executive Committee/Board of Directors. The Executive Committee/Board of Directors shall be responsible for assigning and supervising the activities of the Executive Director. The Executive Director may attend all meetings of this Society, Executive Committee/Board of Directors, Executive Council, and other councils and committees; but shall not have the right to vote or hold office.

A. Duties:

- Provide an annual report to the Tennessee Dental Association
- Attend Board meetings
- Accounting for the Society
 - Pay bills of the Society
 - Produce reports and records for the accounting firm of the Society
 - Keep the executive committee updated periodically on finances of the Society
 - Aid the Treasurer in producing a comprehensive yearly budget
 - Maintain financial records
- Editor of newsletter, includes printing and mailing
- Website Administrator
- Aid the Executive Committee/Board of Directors with communicating with sponsors
- Receive and process meeting reservations
- Maintain attendance records of each meeting
- Work with Program Chairman in giving continuing education credits and program honorarium contracts
- Process membership applications and dues received from the Tennessee Dental Association
- Handle and direct calls from patients and others
- Screen and refer complaints to the Tennessee Dental Association for peer review evaluation
- Editor of the SDDS Annual Program
- Promote the Second District Dental Society and membership
- Assist with the Corporate Sponsorship Program
- Attend leadership workshops and training sessions hosted by the TDA and ADA

B. Terms of Employment:

The Executive Director works for the Executive Committee/Board of Directors. An annual review should be done and the salary set by the Executive Committee/Board of Directors *Advisory Board*. (See employee agreement contract).

Chapter III - Advisory Board

Section 10. PURPOSE: To draw on the historical perspectives and accumulated knowledge of the workings of the SDDS in order to monitor the essentials for long term success - membership, meetings, finances and personnel. It will not replace the responsibilities of the Board of Directors/Executive Committee in the day to day operations of the SDDS including budget, nominations, meetings, etc.

Section 20: COMPOSITION: The Advisory Board shall consist of the President, the Immediate Past-President, the TDA Trustee, the Immediate Past TDA Trustee, the ADA Delegate, the ADA Alternate Delegate, the Earl Henry Chairperson, and the Program Chairperson.

The Executive Director shall be an ex-officio member with the right to vote with the exception of voting on changes in salary.

When one individual occupies more than one of these positions, the President will choose from the Past Presidents of the SDDS to serve as alternates for these positions.

The Advisory Board will pick a chairperson to serve one three year term.

Section 30: QUORUM: Forty (40) percent of the Advisory Board shall constitute a quorum for the transaction of business. The Advisory Board will meet a minimum of once a year.

Section 40: DUTIES:

- *Review the meeting programs and venues from the previous year*
- *Review the budget from the previous year with comparisons to previous budgets*
- *Review the financial operations for accuracy, transparency and accountability*
- *Do performance reviews for paid personnel once a year and make recommendations as to any changes in responsibilities or compensation*
- *Oversee the reserves and accumulated assets outside of the budget*
- *Monitor membership market share trends as well as comparisons to other similar markets in the state and look at ways to increase membership especially among young dentists*
- *Adjudicate any irresolvable disagreements between various components of SDDS*
- *Discuss the future direction for the future success of the SDDS*
