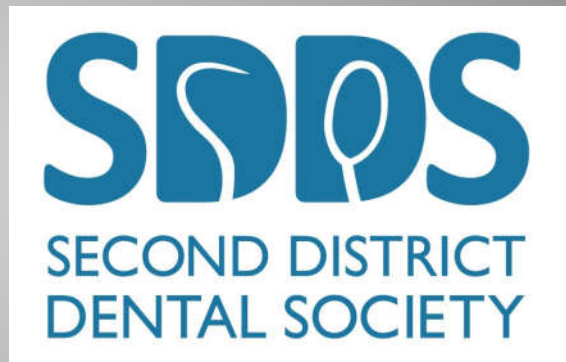

In 2020, he was promoted to associate dean of the UT College of Pharmacy Knoxville campus.
